

## Display Board Information (D & S Inspection)

Note: ARASE affiliates with the Society for Science and the Public (SSP) and follows the Display and safety (D & S) regulations outlined by SSP. The requirements and D & S regulations also apply to the Texas Science and Engineering Fair (TSEF).

### Maximum Size of Display Board: (Table Model or Floor Model)

- Depth (front of table to back of the board): 30 inches.
- Width (side to side): 48 inches.
- Height (floor to top): 108 inches. If the project is a table model, the table is included in the measurement. This also includes the title board.

### Requirements Display Board:

- The **STAMPED Official Abstract/Certification Form** goes on the **upper left-hand side** of the board or **standing up right** on the table with a support. **NOT** flat on the table. If placed on the board, it should be the first item. **DO NOT** use the title "Abstract" on the board. It can also be placed in a plastic cover taped to the edge of the table so that it hangs from the table.
- If the following **SRC Forms** were applicable to the study, they should be displayed be **vertically** on the table, on the board, or be placed in a plastic cover taped to the edge of the table:
  - Form (1C) Regulated Institutional/Industrial Setting
  - Form (7) Continuation Projects
- Science Project Report MUST** be at the **DISPLAY** (in folder, binder, stapled or bound). It needs to **STAY** when students are dismissed. Blue judges need to see it.
- Photographs, diagrams, or flow charts can be used to describe the method or results.
- Photographs, diagrams, charts, graphs, etc. need to have a **CAPTION** and **FIGURE NUMBER**.
- Photographs and/or visual depictions need to have a **CREDIT LINE** or origin. "Photograph taken by ..." or "Image taken from..." One credit line is sufficient if taken by one person or taken from the same source.
- Photos of Humans are allowed **ONLY IF** there is a **PHOTO CONSENT** by participant to display the photo. Student researcher **DOES NOT** need consent nor cover face if in photo.

### Items That DO NOT Go On The Display Board:

- Bibliography **DOES NOT** go on the board. It goes in the report.
- Acknowledgments **DO NOT** go on the board! They go in the science report without names.

### Items NOT ALLOWED at Project or Exhibit:

- Refer to the Intel *International Rules and Guidelines*. Go to [www.societyforscience.org](http://www.societyforscience.org). Go to "Student Science" on the Menu. Click on Intel ISEF. Go to Rules, Forms, and Resources. Click on Rules and scroll down to Display and Safety Regulations.

**NOTE:** Use large print (at least larger than 12 font pt.). It is easier for judges to read.

Start the display from left panel to right so judges can follow the **FLOW** of the experiment like the flow of the report. You can have a photo album and a data log if you wish.
